COVID-19 Guidelines

Ballet Arts is now a "mask optional" facility. We are leaving this choice up to families at this point. Please make sure your dancer knows what your expectation is. Faculty/Staff will not be responsible for enforcement of mask wearing during your dancer's time at Ballet ARTs.

Prior to Arrival

- Please check your dancer for symptoms of COVID 19. Do not send your dancer if he/she/they are exhibiting symptoms
- Please have your dancer use the bathroom at home.
- Dancer should come dressed in required dancewear with their dance shoes. Please limit the amount of "stuff" that comes to class

If your dancer has any symptoms of COVID 19 please do not send them to class.

Upon Arrival

- Dancers should not enter the building more than 5 minutes before the start of their scheduled class.
- Everyone should enter through the front door. Dancers will be excused through the back doors. A responsible adult should meet their dancer there.
- We are strongly encouraging only the dancer enter the building. In the case of younger dancers, one adult may escort the child to their teacher.
- Parents are asked to not wait in the building.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at the front door, please use it before going any further into the building.
- Dancers should arrive and leave with their dance clothes covered and remove extra clothing in their dance room. All personal items must be taken into the classroom.
